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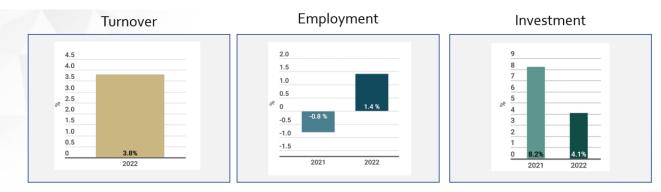

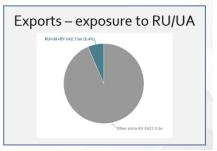




Economic outlook: strong recovery in 2021 but slowdown expected



- +12.8% production in 2021 as our industries saw healthy recovery
- Solid 3.8 % turnover growth forecast for 2022 but major downside risks
- War in Ukraine takes toll on our industries directly and indirectly
- Further price increases and supply disruption aggravating the situation
- Employment expected to grow 1.4% this year

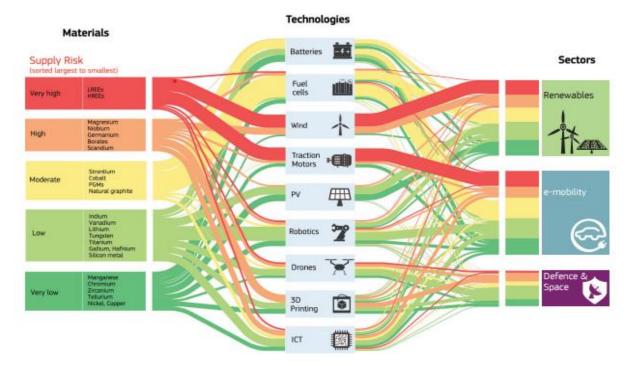




The EU focus: "Strategic Autonomy"

EU mapping of "strategic dependencies"

- 1. "Dependency": high concentration of imports and limited production in the EU
- 2. Bottom-up screening found 137 products in sensitive sectors (6% of EU total import value of goods) for which the EU is highly dependent
- 3. Origin of dependencies: More than 50% originate in China

RePower EU: accelerating clean energy

Bottlenecks:

- Supply chain disruptions
- Limited capacity to invest
- Low or deteriorating market share

Secure capacity to double heat pump installation this year and reach 10 million units until 2025



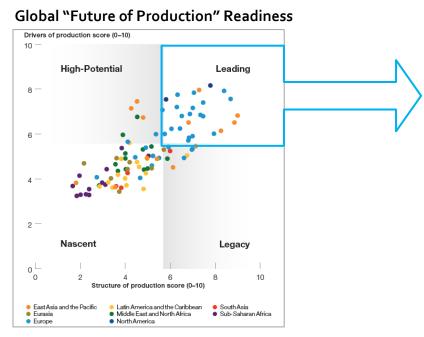
HYDROGEN ELECTROLYSERS
